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All performance figures in this presentation are net of management fees and commissions. Dividends and capital gains are either reinvested or paid in cash to the client core account depending on each client's choice. Either way, the dividend and/or capital gain distributions are included in the client account balance and therefore are included in the returns. Management fees are charged to actual client accounts on a monthly basis. Accounts include both taxable and non-taxable IRA accounts.

MTA Index account returns include all fully invested MTA Index accounts held at Fidelity. These include accounts with 0% leverage up to 100% leverage. MTA Wealth Builder account returns include all fully invested MTA Wealth Builder accounts held at Fidelity. This includes the standard MTA Wealth Builder strategy as well as the conservative version of the MTA Wealth Builder strategy.

Regarding actual performance: Actual performance for all strategies includes all commissions as well as management fees (fees range from 1% to 2%). Actual performance statistics are based on the inception date of each strategy through the end of the last business day of the most recent month listed in the monthly performance section of this report. Starting with Q4, 2006, returns include only assets of Fidelity clients who were fully invested in their respective strategies. Returns before Q4, 2006 include all Fidelity client assets regardless of investment status. Results do not include the assets of clients at other brokerage firms.
